6 am Burlington Safety Patrol helps keep children safe as they are off to school.



7 am Racine Family YMCA summer day camp counselors are getting the activities ready for area children.

8 am A mother participating in Advancing Family Assets meets with her coach to review progress on her monthly financial goals.

9 am Health Care Network begins treating low-income patients, allowing emergency rooms to focus on critical patients.

10 am A volunteer from Lincoln Lutheran plays cards with an elderly woman to give her family care giver a break.

11 am Youth for Christ provides a group session about positive choices for teens involved in the juvenile justice system.

Noon A child in western Racine County receives a new book in the mail from the Imagination Library.

1 pm A single mother with a new infant receives in-home instruction from a trained parent educator through Family Smart/Kid Friendly.

2 pm A new Hispanic family in the community meets with Family Literacy of Racine for English instruction.

3 pm Children arrive at an after school center rather than an empty house thanks to the Racine Afterschool website.

4 pm A mentor from Big Brothers/Big Sisters meets with her assigned child to work on homework together.



5 pm A family enjoys a meal and a fun and educational program together provided by Focus on Community.

6 pm A woman meets with a counselor at Bethany Apts. to create goals for her family to remain safe and abuse free.

7 pm A group of girls are excited to show their parents the crafts they made at Girl Scouts.

8 pm A young man finishes his counseling session at Family Service of Racine.

9 pm The Racine County Food Bank finishes deliveries to neighborhood food pantries.

10 pm Individuals without homes are checking into HALO for an overnight stay.



11 pm A person with developmental disabilities receives education, advocacy and support at The ARC of Racine County.

12 am A runaway youth is brought to Safe Haven for food, clothing, shelter and support.

1 am A young wife is checking into Women's Resource Center to escape abuse.

2 am American Red Cross provides emergency assistance and temporary housing for a family who has lost their home to a fire.

3 am A Sexual Assault Services advocate provides support for a victim of sexual assault at a local hospital.

4 am United Way 2-1-1 is taking calls from individuals needing information and referral to agencies.

5 am A man gets ready for work at the job he obtained from job training at Racine Vocational Ministries.
