This year United Way will invest more than **\$550,000** in programs, services and special projects touching the lives of approximately **30,000 residents** in the communities west of I-94.

Since 2009, United Way has maintained a satellite office in Burlington giving residents more access to United Way resources and helping strengthen partnerships with the local communities.

In 2010, United Way funded programs served western Racine County residents in many ways.

- Counseling services were provided to more than **1,000 individuals**.
- Almost **3,000 students** improved life skills as they learned about healthy habits, safety strategies and getting along in an increasingly diverse world.
- More than **500 families** in Burlington, Union Grove and Waterford received emergency food during the winter months.

Imagination Library was created in 1996 by famed country-singer Dolly Parton to foster a love of reading for all children, regardless of income. All participating children receive free books through the mail each month, from birth to age five.

In 2009, United Way launched the Imagination Library initiative in western Racine County. In 2010, the program doubled from 150 children to more than 350 and growing.
