WHAT YOUR DOLLAR BUYS

Your weekly gift of \$1 (\$52 annually) buys...

- Two preschool children in western Racine County receive a book in the mail every month for a year through Imagination Library.
- More than two hours of bilingual case management through Catholic Charities Outreach Program.
- Thirteen packages of diapers for the Family Smart/Kid Friendly *New Beginnings* program participants.
- Five individuals with a mental illness receive membership services such as newsletters, notice of upcoming programs and access to legislative advocacy initiatives, etc from NAMI Racine.
- One year of activities (like the Christmas Party, Fishing Outing and Sail Boat Ride) for one child through Big Brothers/Big Sisters.
- Fifty-two toothbrushes for children at the HALO shelter.
- One meal per day for four months for one shelter resident through the Racine County Food Bank.
- Two hours of one-on-one counseling sessions and one month of transportation for job searches through Racine Vocational Ministry.
- Orientation training for participants in Leadership Racine.
- Fifty bus tokens for AFA participants to get to school or work.

Your weekly gift of \$5 (\$260 annually) buys...

- Screening and training of one volunteer as a Big Brother or Big Sister.
- Two sessions of mental health treatment by Catholic Charities Behavioral Health Counseling Services for an individual or family with no insurance, little insurance or no means to pay.
- One new, high quality book per month during the school year for all children in one class from Family Literacy of Racine.
- All testing and credentialing costs for two GED students to graduate with GEDs/HSEDs with assistance from Family Literacy of Racine.
- Thirteen booster seats or five infant car seats for low income western Racine County residents through Family Smart/Kid Friendly Partnership.
- A day-long environmental workshop for 75 Girl Scouts.
- Afterschool snacks for 104 students at John XXIII Educational Center.
- An emergency allotment of food to feed 16 families of four for three days from a food pantry supplied by Racine County Food Bank.
- Seven hours of one-on-one counseling sessions through Racine Vocational Ministry.
- Sixteen high school students' participation in three hours of pregnancy prevention (contraceptives and STI) education through the Western Racine County Health Department.
- Participation in a six-week summer program at Lighted Schoolhouse for six AFA children.

Your weekly gift of \$10 (\$520 annually) buys...

- Monthly supervision of one child for a year by a caseworker from Big Brothers/Big Sisters.
- Twenty-six case management sessions through Catholic Charities Outreach Program to help individuals and families become self-sufficient.
- Five sessions of mental health treatment by Catholic Charities Behavioral Health Counseling Services for an individual or family who has no insurance, little insurance or no means to pay.
- All text books needed to teach a class of twelve GED students for a year through Family Literacy of Racine.
- Six new Pack 'n Plays for the Family Smart/Kid Friendly *New Beginnings* program participants.
- A week of tutoring for fourteen school-age children at HALO.
- One shelter resident with three meals per day from the Racine County Food Bank for more than a year.
- Twenty-four hours of job training to a class of twelve participants through Racine Vocational Ministry.
- Thirty-three eighth grade students' participation in nine hours of decision making, healthy relationships, and reproductive health seminars from the Western Racine County Health Department's Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program.
- One month of shelter and services at the Women's Resource Center for a family of four.
- Participation in Dave Ramsey's Financial Peace University for five AFA families.
