



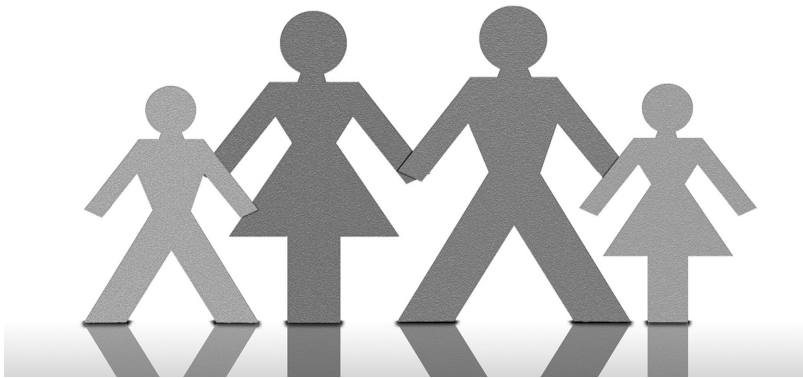
# FACT SHEET FOR FAMILIES

## Your family might be eligible to become an AFA Family if...

- your family income is less than 200% of the Federal poverty level guidelines (see list below);
- your family includes at least one child under age 18;
- you live in Racine County; and
- you or your spouse is employed or has worked at some time within the past 18 months.

### AFA Income Eligibility

# in Family	Maximum Income
1	\$21,780 or \$1,815/month
2	\$29,420 or \$2,452/month
3	\$37,060 or \$3,088/month
4	\$44,700 or \$3,725/month
5	\$52,340 or \$4,362/month
6	\$59,980 or \$4,998/month
7	\$67,620 or \$5,635/month
8	\$75,260 or \$6,272/month

For each additional person, add \$7,640 or \$637/month.
