

C5. SPECIAL FUNDING CONDITIONS AND PERMISSIONS

REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL PROGRAM IN UNITED WAY FUNDING PROCESS

(from currently active Partner Provider organization)

Existing/active United Way Partner Providers must receive permission through the Community Investment Committee (CIC) to add another program to the annual funding process. Prior to November 15 of each year, CIC will review requests to enter the subsequent year's funding process. Organizations must apply online through the Partner Provider Community Investment Website. **You must first notify United Way's Community Investment Administrator (mkallio@unitedwayracine.org) of your interest in requesting permission to add a program.** A *Partner Provider Request for New Funded Program* form will be associated to your profile that includes a brief narrative section:
