Items required to have taxes completed:

- Valid Photo ID
- Social Security Cards for everyone listed on taxes
- W-2, W-2G and 1099-R from all employers
- 1099-Interest and dividend statement from banks
- 1099G – Unemployment Compensation
- 2010 State/Federal tax returns (if possible)
- Documentation of any additional forms of income

If any of the following apply to you, please bring the required documentation:

- Child care expenses, including provider's address and Social Security number or Employer ID number
- Rent Certificate signed by landlord or 2011 property tax bill
- Any notices received from the IRS or WI Dept. of Revenue
- College tuition and student loan interest statements
- Alimony paid or received
- Adoption expenses
