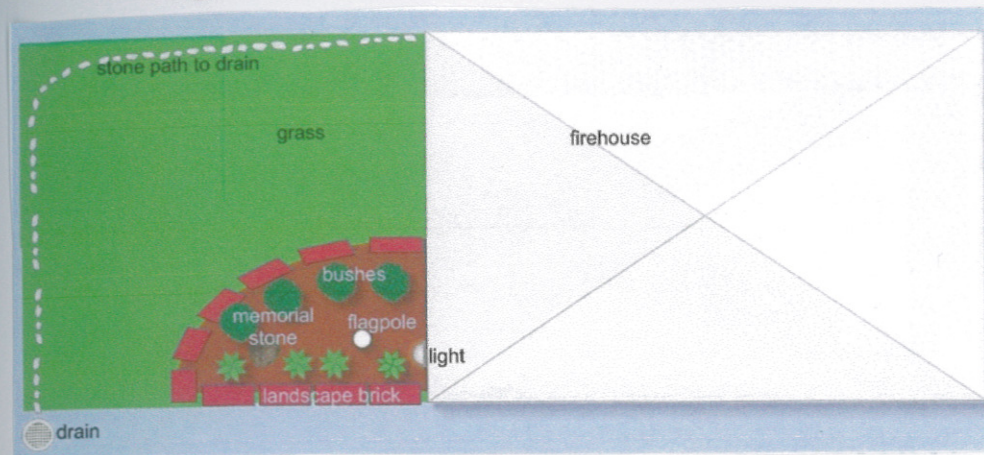

leveled.



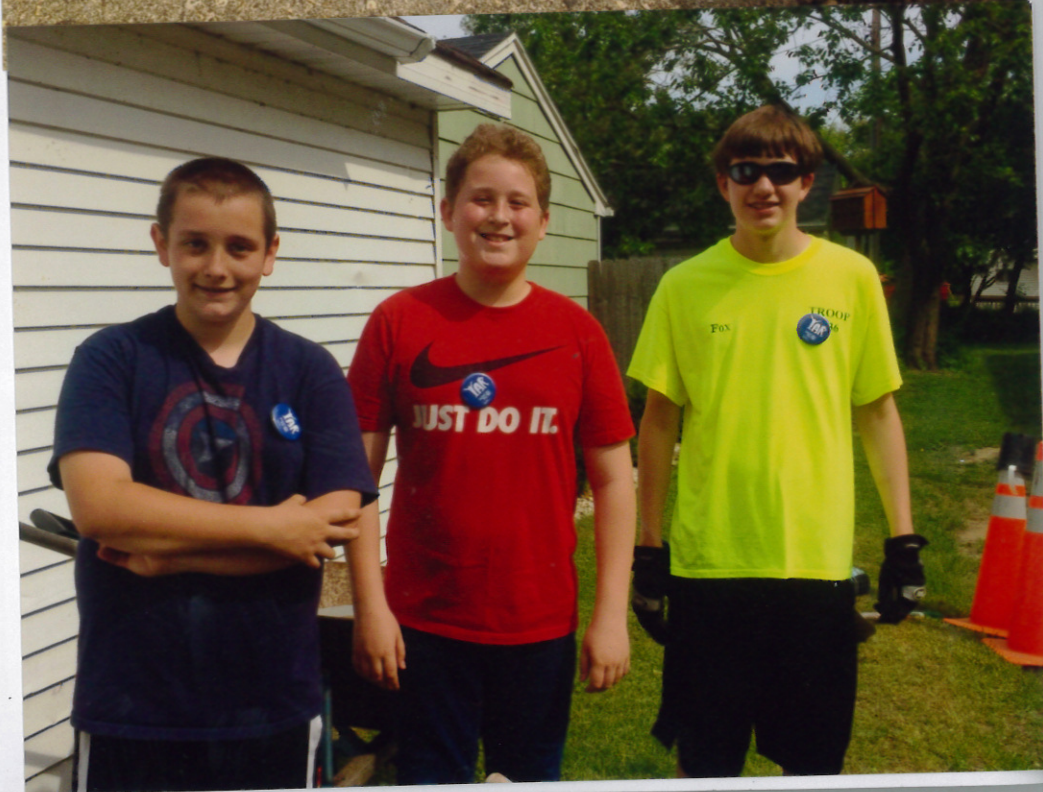


Finally, we put in
