As soon as I got the money, I went to Jo-Ann's Fabric Store and bought enough fabric for 18 pillowcases. I needed 3/4 yd. for the main section, 14 yd. for the coff, 310 in.

I ended up getting:

. 7.5 yards of two different prints

. 5 yards of a cuff, 3 1 yard of a trim.





The fabric was washed all together, which soon became a big problem. It twisted up in the dryer and we had to iron it twice to get out the wrinkles.

CUTING

In order to cut many pieces at once, I had to use a rotary cutter. It looks like this.

HOW TO MAKE A PILLOWCASE!



Cut fabric down to size. 3/4 yol - print 44 yd - cuff Sin. - trim

Layer fabric as follows:

2

folded in half and put on the edge off

coff is put flat

Print is put right side down on the edge of cuff.



Rall print up, and fold cuff up to edge, forming a burrito. Pin 3 sew.



unroll the burrito so that the seam rolls into the inside. Cut excess fabric. (It should look like this.) Fold your pillow cases right sides together. and Seam edges together. Unfold and crease edges. Congratulations! You've made your very first burnitus style pillowcase. NOW MAKE 89 More.

I had to master lining fabric up.


I had trouble at first but after learning a few tricks,

I love the ladybug pillowcase. It can be for any child who wants it is so because it is so universally loved. Even though it curred, it was fun to sew.









The monkeys are some of the last ones I made. I wasn't sure about red and orange it together, but it turned out well. I put it on the lover because I thought it was peryt!




