### Income at or below 200% FPL

**Underserved household**

Your home lacks internet access due to cost.

**Under-connected household**

You live in an area where internet service isn't available or is prohibitively expensive because of a lack of options.

**Have a critical need for digital access that was exacerbated by the COVID-19 public health emergency, related to work/education/health.**

Some examples may be:

- Your child's school used virtual classes but your child couldn't participate because there was no device or internet in the home.
- Your work is able to be completed remotely, but a lack of device or internet connection meant you were laid off.
